The St. Croix Valley Corvette Association meeting minutes for Tuesday April 19<sup>th</sup>, 2019. **The next meeting will be on Tuesday May 21<sup>st</sup>, 2019 at Stillwater Motors at 6:45 PM.** The April meeting was called to order by President Sue Langer at 6:45 PM. Sue led the club in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MEETING MINUTES:** A motion to approve the March 2019 meeting minutes as published in the newsletter was made by Greg Juetten and seconded by Roger Aho. An "aye / nay" vote was taken and the motion passed with all Ayes.
