The May meeting was called to order by President Randy Franke at 7 PM. Note that there were no previous meeting minutes to approve. Randy welcomed everyone to the meeting.

### MEETING NOTES / NEWS:

- **SPRING RUN:** Join Kulas reported for Dave Mikel: There are 22 signed up for the run which is set for Saturday May 22, 2021. There are more details at the end of this newsletter.
- **ANNUAL DINNER SOCIAL and AWARDS BANQUET:** Donna and Marie Reporting
  - Budget Estimate: \$30-\$35/Person (Club covers 50% ???). Includes Food, Paper Products, Recognition Awards, and Rentals (Extra chairs and tables). It was asked if the club would cover 50% of the cost. John Alt made a motion to approve and it was seconded by Bryon Nesheim. A vote by show of hands was taken and it was approved unanimously. Since the event will be held at the Hendrick’s, they have stated that they would not want to host the party unless all attendees (members and spouse / guest) be vaccinated. Asked that the club bullhorn be available, Shep said he would get it.
- **GMCCA:**
  - More workers are needed. An email blast will be sent to all members.
  - For members who bring their car into the show, the club will reimburse them for the fee. See Tom for the reimbursement.

- **CLUB PICNIC / JUNE MEETING:**
  - Scheduled for Tuesday June 15<sup>TH</sup>, 2021.
  - An email has been sent to Dar asking him to reserve the park shelter.
  - **EDITORS’S NOTE:** The park shelters have been reserved.
  - This year the club will not be providing any food and will not be asking the members to bring a plate to pass. Anyone attending should bring their own picnic basket and beverage. Park rules: **NO GLASS CONTAINERS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARK.** The picnic starts at 6:30 PM followed by a short meeting.
- **VACCINATION / SCVCA EVENTS:**
  - This coincides with the request made by the Hendricks at the last meeting that anyone attending the banquet at their house be fully vaccinated. The board agreed with this and recommends that for all events for 2021 be for vaccinated or immune members and be an attendance requirement. John Kulas made a motion that until further notice that only fully vaccinated SCVCA members could attend SCVCA events. The motion was seconded by John Alt.
  - The revised motion was voted on and was approved unanimously.
  - Shep made a motion to add “+ 14 days” to the vaccination requirement. The motion was seconded and passed. The “+ 14 days was added to the original motion
  - The revised motion was voted on and was approved unanimously.
  - Will get info from SWM regarding their COVID rules / requirements.
- **SCVCA/SWM CAR SHOW:**

- SWM will not have a food vendor at the show. It will up to SCVCA to find one. Some suggestions were:
  - Greg suggested asking some of the food vendors at the GMCCA show if they would be interested in coming to our show.
  - Ken asked if there were any charitable organizations in the Valley who could set up a food tent as this was done for past shows.
- **TROPHY COSTS:** Ed reported that the cost would be the same for trophies or plaques - \$450. The sponsor's trophy cost is \$50. The number of trophies and costs were discussed. Suggestions were:
  - Decrease the number of trophies per class.
  - Combine the C1 and C2 classes.
  - Change the voting to give trophies to the top ten vote getters plus one sponsor's trophy.
  - Byron made a motion to award trophies to the top ten vote getters along with the sponsor's trophy. The motion was seconded by Ken. A show of hands was taken and the motion was passed with one no vote.
  - Shep will contact Dar about his vote counting program.
- **OTHER ITEMS:**
  - Shep will contact the Corvette Museum to see if they can attend the show.
  - Ed will ask SWM for some raffle prizes.

  - If you are on 3rd St N and reach 1st Ave N you've gone a little too far
- Central Ave becomes Lake Cir.
- Park is on the right.

From Highway 36:

- Take MN-95 exit toward Stillwater / Bayport.
- Turn right on MN-95 / St. Croix Trail.
- Follow to Central Ave.
- Turn left onto Central Ave.
- Central Ave becomes Lake Cir.
- 1 LAKE CIR is on the right
- Park is on the right.
