SCVCA CAR SHOW REVIEW BY SHEP:

- Paid entrants were down from prior years at 70.
- Expenses down due to our trophy change to top 10; watching expenses closely; and Ed's effort to cut trophy costs.
- John Kulas passed out a car show summary by year for members to review and noted we should be adding funds through the efforts of Shep, Ed Anglo, and Dick Longlet. Major changes were successful in us adding money but cautioned that we were aided by the sponsor's money and their decision to furnish shirts.
