

MEMBER APPRECIATION CELEBRATION:

Randy gave a thank you to: John Kulas for leading the caravan to the Hendricks; A thank you to Donna and Kelly for hosting the event at their house and a huge thank you to Marie and Donna and their spouses for a great program and awards - it left us with the right, right, right feeling!!! There were 59 attendees at this event. They have indicated that they would like an increase in the budget for next year. The board will look into it and bring it to the members.

SCVCA-SWM SHOW:

 If you haven't signed up, just show up and let someone know and they will get you a spot to work. There are gate workers, registration, set up and take down, and people to walk around to solicit for the raffle. Marie has agreed to do this but could use someone to help her collect money, etc.

- Shep said to make sure to bring your cars so we have a fair number of cars for the lookers. Club members should bring their cars and wear their name tags.
- Stillwater Motors paid for the T shirts as well as other costs. We will only have the Taco truck which was at the show last year.
- All club members will get a t-shirt and we will be responsible to giving the paid entrants their free t-shirt.
- Dick said that so far we have collected \$700 in raffle prizes. Proceeds from the raffle will go to local food shelves and Toys for Tots.
- Say thanks to the entrants.
- John Kulas proposed that the club donate a \$100 raffle prize. John Alt seconded it. The motion passed. NOTE: Club members who purchase raffle tickets will not be eligible to win this prize.
- **PARKING:** Club cars need to start in the SW corner and go forward on the grass. We need to make sure the first cars in each class get set up right by generation or it will create a mess.
- New blood for next year's show:

UPDATING THE BYLAWS:

They hope to have a draft for the October meeting. Reminded members that the by laws are online, so look at them and let them know of anything you notice.
